

Christmas Art Contest

- The Cumberland County Public Library is holding a Christmas Art Contest for students in grades PreK to grade 4.
- Only one entry per person is allowed.
- Participants may create an entry on an 8.5 x 11-inch sheet of unlined paper or cardstock that is white or off-white.
- All entries must be the student's original artwork.
- All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form signed by the participant's parent or guardian. NOTE: *By signing the entry form, parents grant permission for their children's winning artwork, first name and last initial, age, grade and/or photo to be put online, used in library publications, displayed in the library and/or attached to each piece of art. No artwork will be used by the library without identifying the artist.*
- The top 10 winning entries will be displayed in the library during December and winning artists will receive a certificate. The overall winning submission will be used on the program cover for the Community Christmas Tree Lighting to be held at the Cumberland County Public Library on December 3, 2018, at 6 PM. Other winning entries may be used in other holiday publications.
- Non-winning artwork that was submitted for the contest may also be displayed in the library during Holiday Boutique and throughout the month of December.
- Parents will be informed of all artwork that will be used either in publications or on display by email and/or telephone.
- All artwork will be returned at the end of December, either to Cumberland County Elementary School (CCES) if the artist is a student or will be available for pickup at the library if the child is not a CCES student.
- The deadline for receiving entries is the close of business on Friday, November 16, 2018.
