Services

Computers: The library maintains free public access computers with basic office software and high speed Internet access. Printouts are \$.20 per page black & white copies and \$.50 color. A printer is available for patrons to print from their own devices.

Wi-Fi: Available without a password, up to five individual or family unit stations are available inside and tables outside for those wishing to use their own laptops or devices.

Public Use Copier: Located at the service desk, the charge is a \$0.20 for black & white (\$0.25 duplex) and \$0.50 for color (\$0.75 duplex). Save \$.10 per page with own paper.

Scanning to USB: 1-9 pages - free, 10 pages and over - \$.10 per page or use scan station.

Fax: Fax service is provided by the staff for a cost of \$1.00 per page sent or received.

Lamination: Lamination is available for \$1.00 per foot, with a minimum fee of \$1.00.

Notary Service: Free notary service is available during the week from 9 AM to 4 PM. Please call in advance.

Digital Access Lockers: Available on the front porch, these lockers provide patrons with opportunities to pick up materials after hours.

Reader for the Visually Impaired: Located in the local history section, this machine enlarges pages onto a screen for easy reading.

Large Print Books: The library offers an extensive collection of large print books.

Meeting Room: The library's meeting room is now available. Please see the director to check on usage.

Public Bulletin Board: A public bulletin board is maintained for the posting of notices for civic and nonprofit organizations and to assist small, local businesses. All notices must be approved by library staff before posting.

The Cumberland County Public Library is a 501(c)(3) non-profit. All donations are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Library Cards

Residents and nonresidents of Cumberland County ages six (6) and older are eligible to obtain a library card. Patrons may register for a card at the circulation desk. Adult patrons must show a photo ID and proof of residency before obtaining a card. Cardholders agree to observe all library policies. Parental permission is required for minors to obtain a card.

Lending Policies

Library materials may be renewed over the phone, in person, by email, or online as long as items have not been placed on HOLD by another patron. Patrons ages 18 and older may check out DVDs. There is a limit of three (3) DVDs per established patron at any one time.

- DVDs check out for 7 days.
- All other library materials check out for 3 weeks.
- Exceptions may be made at the Library Director's discretion.

Overdue Fines

Books and audiobooks: \$0.20 per day per item

DVDs: \$2.00 per day per item

The maximum fine PER ITEM is \$10.00. All overdue fines will be forgiven if materials are returned in good condition AND as long as there was not a Hold waiting on the late materials. Forgiveness does not apply to materials that are lost or damaged. Patrons with fines may not renew or check out material until the fine is paid. Holds are also not available for accounts with fines.

New Card Holders

New patrons are limited to checking out no more than a total of three items, to include no more than one DVD, for their first six (6) weeks as a cardholder. After six weeks, and with their card in good standing (no overdue items or unpaid fines), patrons will gain full borrowing privileges.

Privacy

Your patron record is treated as confidential by the library staff and will not be disclosed to others. However, parents or legal guardians of minors will be notified of the titles and cost of their dependent child's overdue material.

Resources

Books: The library's collection includes a wide variety of fiction and non-fiction titles for adults, young adults, juveniles, and children. We also have a large-print book collection.

Audiobooks: A selection of audiobooks is available in adult fiction and non-fiction as well as for young adults and children.

DVDs: The DVD collection contains both fiction and nonfiction selections, seasons of several popular television series, and videos specially designed for children.
